Appointed Evacuation Shelters are locations to seek refuge in the case of imminent danger, and vary in suitability based on disasters like floods, landslides, storm surges, earthquakes, tsunamis, and large scale fires.

- Appointed Evacuation Shelters are marked on the legend as 「○」 for suitable to use and 「×」 for not suitable to use.
 - During flooding, in some cases, first floors of shelters marked as △ may be unusable.
 - * Flooding is when Yumesakigawa and other major rivers overflow.
 - In the case of a landslide, for shelters marked as △: seek refuge on the 3rd floor and above, away from slopes, for shelters marked as △: only the gymnasium can be used.
 - * When a landslide disaster occurs, a landslide disaster warning will be released.
- Locations marked in green on the table are large scale evacuation sites and correspond with the green areas on the map.
