Appointed Evacuation Shelters vary depending on disasters.
Please use the appropriate evacuation shelter for each disaster.

Appointed Evacuation Shelters are locations to seek refuge in the case of imminent danger, and vary in suitability based on disasters like floods, landslides, storm surges, earthquakes, tsunamis, and large scale fires.
