To ensure smooth garbage collection, please cooperate by **strictly adhering to garbage disposal times**.

## Items the city collects (Domestic garbage) ※ Please note that there will be no collection from January 1st to 3rd.

<b>Burnable Garbage</b> <b>Weekly:</b> ● and ●   Kitchen garbage (Please drain as much water as possible from kitchen garbage) (Kitchen waste, tea dregs, etc.) and non-recyclable paper (e.g., carbon paper) ※For paper diapers, dispose of filth in a toilet and place the diaper in a plastic bag. <b>Large size wastes</b> (Garbage that is roughly over 50 cm) Furniture, styrofoam (pieces that do not fit inside designated bags), massage machines, clothes poles, stoves, wood, pruned branches (of a size that does not fit inside designated bags), spring-loaded mattresses, etc. [Size that can be put out as large garbage] Burnables: 140 cm (width) X 90 cm (height) X 200 cm or less (length) Non-burnables: 90 cm (width) X 90 cm (height) X 180 cm or less (length) Pruned branches must be no more than 20 cm thick and no more than 200 cm long.	<b>Bedding / rugs</b> (Tie the top tightly with strong string) Carpet, Mattresses (without springs), blanket, curtain, electric carpet, cloths/clothing. ※Dispose clothes in a bag that allows the contents to be seen. We are reusing and recycling, so please dispose of anything with your name on it or anything that is dirty as burnable garbage.	<b>Non-burnable garbage</b> on the collection (Non-burnable garbage that is roughly 50 cm or less. Dispose of by putting into a bag that you can almost see through) Ceramics (rice bowls, tableware, ashtrays, makeup bottle etc.), metals (pots, frying pans, toys, hangers, etc.), small appliances (micro-wave ovens, irons, electric kettles, video cassette recorders, printers, etc.), etc.	<b>Dangerous articles</b> Cutlery (razor blades, knives, scissors, etc.), glass (flat glass, glass cups, etc.). ※Wrap those with broken blade edges in thick paper or newspaper, etc., put them in bags that can almost be seen through, and write "dangerous" on the bags before disposing of them in the "basket exclusively for dangerous articles."	<b>Empty bottles</b> (The contents need to be washed and emptied. Remove the cap and cover. Do not put it in a plastic bag when throwing it away.) Transparent Brown Other ※Glass bottles that contained materials other than drink or food, are made of heat resistant glass (glass pots and covers) and glass cosmetics bottles must be categorized as non-burnable garbage.	
<b>Plastic bottles</b> (Wash, remove covers and labels, crush.) "Identification Display Mark" "Material Indication Mark" Recycled into PET bottles. ※Take off covers and labels, and throw them out as plastic containers and packs.	<b>Paper cartons</b> (washed, open and dried) Paper packages of 500ml or bigger ※Throw paper package of less than 500ml in size as a "paper wastes". ※When the inside of a package is brown or laminated with aluminum foil, treat it as burnable garbage.	<b>Empty cans</b> (Contents must be emptied. Remove the caps and covers. Do not put them in plastic bags when throwing them away.) Empty cans less than 20 liters in size ※Spray cans and gas cylinders for home cooking can cause explosions and/or fire. Make sure you use up the contents and punch a hole in each can before throwing them away. (See the back as well.)	<b>Fluorescent tubes</b> (Put these items in bins for fluorescent tubes without breaking them.) Fluorescent tubes, incandescent lightbulbs, LED bulbs, and similar items ※Dispose of these items without putting them in boxes. ※If any of these items are broken, put them in transparent bags.	<b>Batteries and similar items</b> (Put these items in battery recycling bins without breaking them.) Batteries, Lithium primary batteries, clinical mercury thermometers, mercury thermometers, mercury manometers, and similar items ※Please insulate coin cell lithium batteries (with model numbers CR or BR) with cellophane tape, etc. before discarding. ※Small rechargeable batteries / button cell batteries (with model numbers starting with LR, SR, or PR) are to be disposed of at stores. ※If any of these items are broken, put them in transparent bags. ※Mercury-free thermometers should be disposed of as nonburnable garbage.	<b>Used paper</b> (Newspaper, cardboard and magazines should each be securely tied up in bundles with string.) Newspaper (including advertising leaflets) Corrugated cardboard Magazines ※Please dispose of items with metal fittings, such as albums, as combustible waste.

## Items the city does not collect (These cannot be put out at garbage collection spot.)

<b>Designated Home Electric Appliances</b> TVs, refrigerators and freezers (including wine fridges, coolers and chillers), washing machines and clothes dryers, air conditioners (including outdoor units) cannot be disposed of at the bulky waste station or brought to Clean center. Please have them picked up by your nearest retail store. (See the back as well.)	<b>Personal computers for home use</b> Ask the manufacturer or a delivery service to collect the home computer and display. (See the back as well.)	<b>Hazardous waste that cannot be discharged</b> These items should be returned to the shop or store where the item was purchased. Gas bottles, scuba bottles, fire extinguishers, tires, batteries, residual paint, petroleum, poisons, water server, and motorbikes, syringes, etc.	<b>Excessive amount of garbage</b> Carry garbage from moving, heavy items weighing 50kg or over, a large quantity of wooden pieces, and pruning branches direct to the Kuresaka Clean Center (Refer to the back side.) for disposal or use a fare-paying service of a collection contractor authorized by the city. You cannot put them out at the garbage collection spot. (Paid) [List of collection companies approved by the city]	<b>Waste from stores and offices</b> According to the law, it is the responsibility of each industry to dispose of their own industrial garbage. 1 Try to recycle/return items back to resources. 2 Dispose of the item by yourself. 3 Ask city approved garbage collection dealers to dispose of the item. (for a fee)



## How to Dispose of Designated Home Electric Appliances

Televisions, refrigerators and freezers (wine coolers, mini refrigerators, and cold and warm storage units included), washing machines and clothes dryers, air conditioners (outdoor units included) cannot be disposed of at collection points for bulky garbage and cannot be dropped off at the Kuresaka Clean Center. Visit a nearby retail store and pay a recycling fee and a collection fee to have them collect your garbage. Please note that post offices only handle the payment of recycling fees and are not involved in the recycling process itself. For inquiries regarding specific household appliances, please contact the Home Appliance Recycling Ticket Center (☎0120-319640).



## How to dispose of used personal computer



- Collection by manufacturer (apply to each maker.)
  - ※ Products with PC-recycle mark are not charged for collection and recycling.
  - ※ Attached accessories like mouse, keyboard and speaker, etc. can be packed together.
  - ※ If you cannot access the manufacturer, call 03-5282-7685 (an incorporated association pasokon 3R suishin kyokai).
- Collected by delivery service (Please apply to the cooperating company, Renet Japan Recycle Co., Ltd. ☎0570-085-800)
  - ※ Access through internet (<https://www.renet.jp>), delivery agent will visit you to retrieve your computer.
  - ※ One box containing a computer, total sizes 140cm, within 20 kg, is free of charge and peripheral devices (e.g. printers, mouse, and scanners, etc.) can be packed together.
  - ※ There is a private-data-deleting service. (For a charge) For more information, access to the homepage of Renet Japan Recycle Co., Ltd.

## Announcement from the Kuresaka Clean Center

Do not put a bulky trash of house moving and a big clean up, pruning branches, a large amount of weeds, house demolition debris. But directly bring into the Kuresaka Clean Center.

● Drop-off dates and times **Monday through Friday (public holidays included)**  
※ For the New Year holidays and Golden Week, make inquiries.

**8:30-12:00**

**13:00-16:30**

● Acceptable trash Burnable trash, the non flammable, bulky waste, pruning branches, house demolition debris.

● Fee: 130 yen / 10 kg

● Notes on bringing waste

- ① You cannot bring in industrial wastes.
- ② Concerning large garbage, bring in after breaking down into parts measuring no or less 140cmx90cmx200cm in the case of burnable garbage and 90cmx90cmx180cm in the case of non-flammable garbage.
- ③ Break blocks and concrete down to pieces measuring no or less 20cm before bringing in. Also, remove any burnable contents or waste metal, etc.

- ④ Break pruned branches down to pieces measuring no or less 60cm x 150cm before bringing in. Rough wood may be carried in, but waste roots are not acceptable. Also, when bringing garbage in, cover with a sheet, etc. to stop fly off.
- ⑤ You cannot bring in TV sets, refrigerators · freezers, washing machines · clothes driers, air conditioners (including outdoor units.), personal computers, cars and motorbikes, hazardous objects such as chemicals, and objects in excess of the standard size.
- ⑥ The disposing person or a family member is asked to be in attendance.
- ⑦ When bringing in pruned branches, grass and debris from house demolition, use a vehicle with capacity no greater than 3t. Also, do not use a poorly serviced vehicle or allow an inexperienced driver to operate the vehicle.
- ⑧ Bring in garbage after first conducting thorough separation.
- ⑨ A disposal of house demolition (not by a professional contractor) debris requires to submit "General Waste Disposal Request." Access below and make an application procedure before hand.

## Concerning disposal of spray cans and disposable lighters

There are frequent outbreaks of **fire in waste collection trucks** Waste processing facility thought to be caused by **spray cans** and **disposable lighters**.


### Spray cans

Be sure to use up the contents and punch a hole outdoors in a well ventilated place. Dispose in the "Empty Cans" section.



### Disposable lighter

Be sure to use up the contents and dispose as "**Burnable Garbage**".  
※ You can remove gas from lighters by using a rubber band or adhesive tape.



## Never dispose of syringes (syringe needles) or other similar items!

**Be sure to consult a medical institution or pharmacy regarding the disposal of syringes (needles).**

※ Injection needles, pen-type syringes, and needles for measuring blood sugar levels may be mixed in sorted garbage such as "plastic containers and packs," "plastic bottles," and "empty bottles." Sorted waste is manually removed by sorting workers to remove foreign matter, and sharp objects such as needles may cause worker injuries or infectious diseases. Please do not dispose of it as separate garbage.



Contact medical institutions or pharmacies.

## Recycling of small electrical appliances

There are collection boxes for small electrical appliances at every facility, as these appliances contain precious resources that can be recycled.

**[Collected Items]**  
Items that fit into the collection box (50cm x 15cm)  
Cell phones, PCs, Smartphones, Tablets, etc.

**[Collection Locations]**  
Drop your items off during the business hours of the facility.  
1st-floor lobby of Himeji City Hall, Branch offices, Regional offices, City Office in front of Himeji Station, Local offices, Service Centers, Ichikawa Waste Processing Facility, Jonai Library, Shikama Library Annex

- ◆ Cautions ◆
- ① Be sure to delete any personal information.
- ② Only household waste is accepted.
- ③ Once compact appliances are put into a collection box, they cannot be returned.
- ④ Remove all the batteries, rechargeable batteries, or other similar items that can be removed.
- ⑤ Certain electrical appliances cannot be thrown away.
