

How to Dispose of Designated Home Electric Appliances Televisions, refrigerators and freezers (wine coolers, mini refrigerators, and cold and warm storage units included), washing machines and clothes dryers, air conditioners (outdoor units included) cannot be disposed of at collection points for bulky garbage and cannot be dropped off at the Beautification Center. Visit a nearby retail store and pay a recycling fee and a collection fee to have them collect your garbane. To dispose of your garbage yourself, buy a Home Appliance Recycle Ticket at a post office, and contact one of the following designated collection points by phone before dropping your garbage off . 



* Injection needles, pen-type syringes, and needles for measuring blood sugar levels may be mixed in sorted garbage such as "plastic containers and packs," "plastic bottles," and "empty bottles." Sorted waste is manually removed by sorting workers to remove foreign matter, and sharp objects such as needles may cause worker injuries or infectious diseases.
